



What we do:

- Distribute 125,000+ lbs or more of food to 6,500 people per year
- Raise and/or distribute \$25,000 of direct financial assistance to pay utilities, prescriptions, and prevent evictions.
- Establish and review budgets for 100+ families per year
- Conduct classes on basic living skills for families ready to make a change
- Refer thousands of families to the appropriate service or agency to assist them

Why we do it:

- To invite people into our facility so we can begin to form relationships with them
- To encourage families to build a relationship with a local church
- To give families the tools necessary to become self-sufficient and break the generational cycle of poverty
- To share the love of Christ in word and in deed

How do we do it:

- No state or federal money is used for the funding of Project Hope
- We have one location -- 1808 143rd Ave in Dorr at the corner of 18th and 143rd
- We rely on the gifts of local churches and individuals for 100% of our support
- We use 3 paid staff and 40+ volunteers to run the ministry center.
- We run a thrift store at our location called Annetta's Garage to assist with funding. Hours are Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday from 10 - 5; Thursday from 10 - 8 and Saturday from 10 -2.
